The Same ... } Thomas Adams appears according to his recognizance to give evidence on behalf of his Lordship against John Deal and Thomas Bliard and is discharged herefrom whereupon the said Thomas Adams is ordered to give new recognizance for his appearance at March Court next to give evidence on behalf of his Lordship against John Deal and Thomas Bliard &c.

Thereupon the said Thomas Adams with Joseph Gray of Somerset County planter his self both present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors in the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling each of their goods and Chattels Land & tenements severately to be made and levied to the use of his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors If it happen that the said Thomas Adams do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwiding Creeke the third Tuesday of March next and then and there do not give such evidence as he knows on behalf of his Lordship against the aforesaid John Deal and Thomas Bliard of and concerning a certain trespass and assault by them supposed to be committed and done and do depart the same Court without leave &c
