On the backside of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was thus Endorsed by William
Reddish foreman of the grand Jury that he should be called in at the assizes

Thereupon it is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should cause
to come here before the Justices aforesaid Twelve Mr. by whom &c. and who neither &c. to Recognize &c.
because as well & and afterward, immediately came the Jury &c. and the Jurors of the same
Jury by Joseph McClester gent. Sheriff of the County affd to this Indictment being called came to

Whereas it is considered by the Justices here that the aforesaid John Callinan pay unto the affd
John Reddish the party deprived four pound of the value of the Money and book affd Stolen amounting
in the whole to twelve pounds Sixteen Shillings curr. money of Maryland and that the said John Callinan
be whipt with twenty stripes on the bare Back wile laid on while the blood appear and that he
stand immediately in the pillory half an hour. and that he be taken &c. and thereupon as to the forgo-
rate punishment affd Command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do hereof immediately
execute according to the Judgment affd Rendered by whipping the affd John Callinan at the Publick
whipping post with twenty stripes on the Bare Back wile laid on while the blood appear and by
setting him in the pillory half an hour and afterward in the same Court came the said Sheriff
and made a Return that he had done the Execution of the Judgment affd as to the forgoate punish-
ment aforesaid he was commanded — whereupon the said John Callinan is ordered to give —
