Goldsmith Gent his Lordships attorney and who for his said Lordship in that part followeth Take care
Thereupon it is Commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should cause
to come here before the Justices aforesaid Twelve Men by whom he and who neither he to Recognize
because as well he and afterwards immediately came the Jury and the Jurors of that same
Jury by Joseph M. Leder Gent. Sheriff of the County aforesaid to this Inquest called being called came to
with Matthew Hopkins John Williams William Parit Phillip Quinton Peter Claywell Thomas Burt

be whipt with twenty Stripes on the bare Back well laid on until the blood appear and that he
stand immediately in the pillory half an hour. and that he be taken &c. and thereupon as to the corpo-
rate punishment aforesaid Command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do there of immediately
Execution according to the Judgment aforesaid Rendered by whipping the said John Callinan at the Publick
whipping post with twenty Stripes on the bare Back well laid on until the blood appear and by
setting him in the pillory half an hour. and afterwards in the same Court came the said Sheriff
and made Return that he had done the Execution of the Judgment aforesaid as to the corporeall punish-
ment aforesaid he was Commanded... whereupon the said John Callinan ^{present Coram Court} is ordered to give
