All which said next Court to wit the eighteenth day of November anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five came againe as well the said William Goldborough his Lordship's attorney who for his said Lordship in this part followeth as the aforesaid John White by his attorney aforesaid and thereupon the said John White as before defendeth the fore said Injury when &c. and saith that he is not guilty of the premises in the Information aforesaid above upon him Imposed ~~himself~~ and of this he putteth himself himself upon the Country and William Goldborough who for his said Lordship in this behalfe followeth Likewise &c.
