of the peace within the County aforesaid by the above named Day Scott and Andrew Scott that aforesaid
Hendry above named is justly indebted unto him as appears by the above auct. and that the said
John is run away or removed in a secret manner from his place of abode and has carried or is
about to carry or remove his Effects or Substance to defraud his Creditor &c.

pedlar. if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of three pounds Curr. money of Maryland
and six hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in
your Custody safekeep so that you have the same before an Justice of our County Court of Somerset.
