Command you of your Attacke any of y^r Goods Chattels Rights or
Credits of William Jennings late of Somerst County Gent: if they
shall be found in your Bailewick to y^r Value of Nine hundred Pounds
of tobacco and where you have the same attached or any part thereof
the same in your Custody safe keep so that you the same before
our Justices of our County Court of Somerst to be held at
Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November next there & there
to be condemned According to Act of Assembly to and for y^r use
of a certaine John Lynch Unlesse the said William Jennings by
himselfe or his attorney shall appear & answer unto y^r Sd John
Lynch in a daye of triall upon the last day according to law
that by good & lawfull man of your Bailewick you make
known unto y^r person or persons in whose hands you make
y^r same attachment that he she or they be & appear before
our Justices of our County Court of Somerst to be held as af^d
to new cause if any he she or they have whis y^r same goods
Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands
ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made
(According to act of Assembly in such case made and provided) if
to him her or them it shall seeme meet and how you shall execute
this writt that you make knowne unto our Sd Justices at this daye
placed aff^d & have you here and thid this writt witness Robert King
Gent: First Justice of our Sd Court the twenty second day of August
In the twenty first year of our Dominion & Anno Domini One
thousand Seven hundred and thirty five

At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the eighteenth
day of the same month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred
and thirty five being the day of y^r returne of the same writt came the
said John Lynch by Francis Alder his attorney and the Sheriff of
Somerst County to whom the foregoing writt was directed Likewise
comette and maketh returne the 20th to this Court hereunder in these
