Somerset J. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon  
Lord Baron of Baltimore. To the Sheriff of Somerset County Greeting we  
Command you if you Attack any of the Goods Chattels Rights or  
Credits of William Jennings late of Somerset County Gent. if they  
shall be found in your Bailiwicks to the Value of Nine hundred Pounds  
of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof  
the same in your Custody safe keep so that you the same before  
our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at  
dividing Court the third Tuesday of November next there & there  
to be condemned According to Act of Assembly to and for the use  
of a certain John Lynch Unless the said William Jennings by  
himself or his attorney shall appear & answer unto the said John  
Lynch in a plea of trespass upon the fact & according to law  
& that by good & lawful men of your Bailiwicks you make  
known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make  
of said attachment that he she or they be & appear before  
our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held as aforesaid  
to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods  
Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands  
ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made  
(According to Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided) if  
to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute  
this writt that you make known unto our sd. Justices at the day &  
place aforesaid & have you there and there this writt Witness Robert King  
Gent. Chief Justice of our sd. Court the twenty second day of August  
In the twenty first Year of our Dominion &c. Anno Domini One  
thousand Seven hundred and thirty five

All which said third Tueday of November to wit the eighteenth  
day of the said month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred  
and thirty five being the day of the return of the said writt with came the  
said John Lynch by Francis Alden his attorney and the Sheriff of  
Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed likewise  
cometh and maketh the return thereof to the Court here shewed in these  
words following viz.
