Whereupon the aforesaid Richard Hickman, Francis Wharton, Benjamin Derrison and George  
Howard Garnishees as aforesaid being severally called Comes not but makes default &c

Thereupon the aforesaid John Lynch by his attorney aforesaid present here in Court pray  
that upon giving security according to act of assembly in such case made and provided the aforesaid  
sum of nine hundred pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid attached may be condemned in the hands of the  
said Richard Hickman Francis Wharton Benjamin Derrison and George Howard as of the Rights  
& Credits of the aforesaid William Jennings towards satisfying unto the said John Lynch the aforesaid five  
hundred & four pounds of Tobacco and all costs and Charges expended by occasion of the attachment aforesaid.

Whereupon Francis Allen of Somerset County Gentleman present here in  
Court in his proper person undertook for the said John Lynch  
according to act of assembly in such case made and provided that in  
case the said William Jennings do at any time within a year & a day  
appear and make all or any part of the said Lynch's claim against  
him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to be void before the laying  
of this attachment that then the said John Lynch shall make  
restitution unto him the said William Jennings of all or such part  
thereof as shall be made appear to be void &c or that he the  
said Francis Allen will do the same for him &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here that the aforesaid sum of nine hundred  
pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid attached be condemned in the hands of the aforesaid  
Richard Hickman Francis Wharton Benjamin Derrison and George Howard as of the  
Rights and Credits of the said William Jennings towards satisfying unto the said John Lynch as  
well the aforesaid sum of five hundred and four pounds of Tobacco as also all costs and Charges  
accruing upon the attachment aforesaid and that the said John Lynch have thereof execution  
against the said Richard Hickman, Francis Wharton, Benj<sup>s</sup> Derrison and Geo. Howard according  
to act of assembly &c
