Whereupon the aforesaid Richard Hickman, Francis Wharton, Benjamin Derrickson and George
Howard garnishee as aforesaid being severally called comes not but makes default &c

Thereupon the aforesaid John Lynch by his attorney aforesaid present here in Court pray
that upon giving security according to act of assembly in such case made and provided the aforesaid
sum of Nine hundred pounds of tobacco so as aforesaid be condemned in the hands of the
said Richard Hickman Francis Wharton Benjamin Derrickson and George Howard as of the Rights
and Credits of the said William Jennings towards satisfying unto the said John Lynch the sum five -
hundred and four pounds of tobacco and all costs and charges expended by reason of the attachment aforesaid

Whereupon Francis Allen of Somerset County Gentleman present here in
Court in his proper person undertook for the said John Lynch
according to act of assembly in such case made and provided that in
case the said William Jennings do at any time within a year & day
appear and make all or any part of the said Lynch's claims against
him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to be avoided before the laying
of this attachment that then the said John Lynch shall make
restitution unto him the said William Jennings of all or such part
thereof as shall be made appear to be avoided &c or that the
said Francis Allen will do the same for him &c

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the aforesaid sum of nine hundred
and four pounds of tobacco so aforesaid attached be condemned in the hands of the aforesaid —
Richard Hickman Francis Wharton Benjamin Derrickson and George Howard as of the
Rights and Credits of the said William Jennings towards satisfying unto the said John Lynch as
well the sum of five hundred and four pounds of tobacco as also all costs and charges
accruing upon the attachment aforesaid and that the said John Lynch have hereof Execution
against the said Richard Hickman, Francis Wharton, Benjamin Derrickson and Geo. Howard according
to act of assembly above —
