afterwards to wit the day & year last mentioned at the County afo: this
said John Aydelott of the Indorsement afo: had notice by means
whereof & also by force of the Statute in that case lately made and
provided the said John Aydelott became chargeable to pay to the
said John Watson the said Eight hundred & eighty eight pounds of
tobacco in the note afo: mentioned according to the tenor of the said
note & the Indorsement thereupon as is afo: made & being so thereof
