day of the same month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred  
and thirty five being the day of the return of the same writ came  
the said John Watson by his attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Somerset  
County to whom the foregoing writ was directed likewise comette  
and make the return thereof to the Court hereunder written <sup>in the place before laying</sup>

Whereupon the said John Aydelott present herein in his  
proper person in the said Court adjudged to give speciall  
Bail to the action of the said Thersupon a certaine John Gage late  
of Somerset County planter from his late Court in his proper  
person and undertooke for the said John Aydelott and assumed  
upon himselfe (likewise the said John Aydelott assumed upon  
himselfe) that it in God his said John Watson should recover judgment  
in the sum aforesaid against the said John Aydelott or that the  
said John Aydelott should be therin convicted that when he the said John  
Aydelott should pay the Condemnation of the Court Thersupon or tender  
his body in Execution of such Judgment to the Prison of the  
Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he the  
said John Gage will do the same for him &c.

And here uppon the said John Aydelott by Francis Allen his attorney prays that the aforesaid  
John Watson may give security for costs in case he be blamed against him in the ple aforesaid which  
is by the Court granted Whereupon a certain James Martin of Somerset County Gentleman present  
here in Court in his proper person undertakes for the said John Watson that he have no cause to be nonsuited  
in the ple aforesaid or otherwise legally cast that then the said John Watson shall pay the Condemnation  
of the Court Thersupon and all costs ensuing thereon to the said John Watson or that he the said  
James Martin will do his same for him &c. And the said John Aydelott by Francis  
Allen his attorney comes and definds the said John Watson that he have no cause to be nonsuited  
in the ple aforesaid or otherwise legally cast that then the said John Watson shall pay the Condemnation  
of the Court Thersupon and all costs ensuing thereon to the said John Watson or that he the said  
John Watson above agt. him hath complained and of this he  
putte himself upon the Country &c. And Thersupon
