belinquisheth his Verification aforesaid by him above alledged and says  
that he cannot Gainway the action aforesaid of the aforesaid John Watson nor  
can he say but that he did asume upon himself in manner and form  
as the aforesaid John Watson above against him hath complained and as  
to the damages of the said John Watson by him by Occasion of the  
promises in that part sustained the said John Aydelott saith and  
confesseth that the aforesaid John Watson hath sustained damages by  
Occasion of the promises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about  
his suit in that part appoynted to Eight hundred and Eighty Eight  
pounds of tobacco and not more and because the aforesaid John Watson deny  
not this but the said allegation confesseth to be true pray Judgment for  
those damages above sayd together with his Costs and Charges aforesaid to  
him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is considered by the Court here  
that the aforesaid John Watson recover against the aforesaid John Aydelott his damages  
aforesaid to the aforesaid Eight hundred and Eighty Eight pounds of tobacco in fam  
of confesseth as also Eight hundred & thirty nine pounds  
of tobacco for his Costs and Charges aforesaid to the said John Watson  
by the Court here and Consent of the parties aforesaid adjudged and the aforesaid  
Defendant in mercy &c.

of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November  
next to answer unto John Williams of aforesaid of trespass upon the case &c.  
And that thereof he should not fail &c.

And the aforesaid John Williams by Robert Senckins Henry his attorney  
complains the against the aforesaid Martin Fenton in the aforesaid case as  
followeth Viz.

Somerset County Martin Fenton late of Somerset County Cordwainer  
was attached to answer unto John Williams in aforesaid of trespass upon  
the case &c.

And whereupon J. S. John by Robert  
Senckins Henry his attorney complains if whereas J. aforesaid Martin the  
J. second day of October Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred &  
thirty & five at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was  
indebted unto the said John in the sum of Sixty five pounds and  
seven pence half penny Current money of Maryland for sundry  
(Propert)
