paines and swelling in his Limbs being unable to Labour your petitioner humbly prayeth
that your worships will please to set him tax free and your petitioner as in duty bound shall
ever pray ---

The petition afo being read and heard and fully understood wherefore
it is considered by the Court here that the afo Isaac Williams be discharged from paying of
taxes for the afo negro until such time as the afo negro shall be restored to the ability of
body for the Labouring in such sort as may be thought sufficient for the paying of his taxes

Lazarus Maddox } To the worshipful Justices of Somerset County now in Court

sitting the humble petition of Daniel Maddox sheweth whereas
Your petitioner having an negro man distracted Raving mad and wholly incapable of
any services therefore prays your worships will set him tax free and your petitioner as
in duty bound shall ever pray &c.

The petition afo being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation there-
upon had wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the afo said Lazarus Maddox be dis-
charged from paying of Taxes for the afo negro as by the petition afo is proved &c.

Upon the motion of William Goldsbrough Gent. Clerk of the Inditment. for Somerset County It
is ordered that the Sheriff of Somerset County return a panelle of Grand Jurors here immediately to
Enquire for his Majesty the right honourable the Lord Proprietary and the body of this County of
Somerset afterwards in the same Court time the said Sheriff to wit Joseph M. Carter Gent and made
return to the Court here of the panelle of the following Grand Jurors Joshua Caldwell Christopher
Biper John Larrimore Joshua Surges William Adams Cornelius Dickerson, William
Gibby Edward Beachamp Richard Nicholson, John Kellum John Aydelott John Collins James Hon-
-ton Thomas Larrimore John Bewins Hutton John Underwood Beucher - whereupon proclama-
-tion being made in usual form, and thereupon they were sworn and charged
