Attorneys affd. and whereupon the said William Jones prays fur-  
ther leave thereof to Imparle hereuntill next Court and he hath  
it and the same day is given to the affd John Rider herealso &c. —  
Att which said next Court to wit the Eighteenth day of Novem-  
ber Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty five com-  
against as well the affd John Rider as the affd William Jones by their  
attorneys affd and thereupon the said William Jones as before  
defends the force and Injury whereto and saith that he the affd William  
never was Bailliff of him the said John at Womdsell County affd  
in manner & form as the affd John above agt. him hath complained  
and of this he puts himself upon the Country &c.  
Generall Demurrer, Rider in Demurrd,

Att which day last above mentioned came hereinto Court the aforesaid William Jones by his  
attorney affred and the aforesaid John Rider at the same day of the plea being solemnly called  
Comittit not nor is he with Declaration affd further prosecuted &c.

Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the affd John Rider and his pledges  
of prosecuting h with John Doe and Richard Roe be in mercy and that the affd William Jones for  
lack of willfull day &c. also it is considered that the aforesaid William Jones Recover against the  
aforesaid John Rider his damages by reason of the premises to Two hundred

200 pounds of tobacco to the same William at his request for his costs and charges in that part  
sustained according to the sum of the Statute Head of Costs made and provided by the Court here  
adjudged and the aforesaid William Head of Costs

And Whereupon the same John Britt by Francis

for him the affd John White so much as the affd John Britt for  
the Service & labour of the affd Negro should reasonably deserve
