Chargable to pay unto the aff<sup>d</sup> John Reddish the aff<sup>d</sup> thirty three bushells and threes<sup>d</sup> pecks of Indian corn according to the tenor of the notes aff<sup>d</sup> and so therewith being chargable the said John Wilcox in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the said eighteenth day of April in the year aff<sup>d</sup> at the County aff<sup>d</sup> upon himself did assume and to the said John Reddish then and there faithfully did promise that he the said John Wilcox the said thirty three bushells and threes<sup>d</sup> pecks of Indian corn to the said John Reddish according to the tenor of the note aff<sup>d</sup> well and faithfully would paye content notwithstanding the aff<sup>d</sup> John Wilcox his promise and assumption aff<sup>d</sup> so as aff<sup>d</sup> made nothing regarding but misleading and fraudulently intending the said John Reddish in this part craftily and subtilly to decieve and defraud the aff<sup>d</sup> thirty three bushells and threes<sup>d</sup> pecks of Indian corn to the said John Reddish altho' do the said by the said John Reddish afterwards to wit the eleventh day of November in the year aff<sup>d</sup> at the County aff<sup>d</sup> before aff<sup>d</sup> afterwards thereto the said John Wilcox was required hath not paid but that unto him to pay or for the same in any sort to content hitherto altho' ther hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the said John Reddish Seven pounds current money and therof her brings suit &c — Bldgs & Inst doer R. R.  
Whereupon the said John Wilcox present herein Court in his proper person is by the said Court adjudged to give speciall bail to the action aff<sup>d</sup> Thereupon a certain Henry Toadvine <sup>late</sup> of Somerset County planter came herein Court in his proper person and undertooke for the said John Wilcox and assumed upon himselfe (likewise the said John Wilcox assumed upon himselfe) that if in case the said John Reddish should recover judgment in the plai. aff<sup>d</sup> against the said John Wilcox or that the said John Wilcox should be therin convicted that then by the said John Wilcox should pay the condamnation off the Court therupon or render his body in execution of such judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that by the said Henry Toadvine will do the same for him &c —

And the aforesaid John Wilcox by Francis Allen his attorney cometh and defendeth the said force and Injury wher<sup>t</sup> he and prayeth leave therof to Ingars<sup>t</sup> heruntill next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aff<sup>d</sup> John Reddish heralso &c —

At which said next Court to wit the nineteenth day of June of June Ann<sup>d</sup> Dom<sup>d</sup> One thousand Seven hundred and thirty five came against as well the aff<sup>d</sup> John Reddish as the aff<sup>d</sup> John Wilcox by their attorneys aff<sup>d</sup> and whereupon the said John Wilcox prays further leave therof to Ingars<sup>t</sup> heruntill next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aff<sup>d</sup> John Reddish heralso &c — At which said next Court to wit the Nineteenth day of August Ann<sup>d</sup>
