and within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the said John
Williams in the sum of Nineteen pounds Six Shillings & Seven
pence Current money of Maryland for divers Goods wares Merchants
divers of the said John Williams by him before that time sold and deliv-
ered to the said David Smith at his Special Instances request as
by an Acc't he to witness may more fully & at large appear and being
so indebted, the said David afterwards (to wit) the same day and year
at Somerset County aforesd in Consideration thereof then and there
undertook & faithfully promised that he the said David Smith would
well & truly content and pay to the said John the sum of Nine-
teen pounds Six Shillings & Seven pence when & so after he should
be required thereto witnesseth the said David not regarding his
promise made in this manner as above but contending and frau-
dulently intending craftily & subtilly to deceive and defraud the
said John in this particular, hath not paid the said sum or any
part thereof to the said John nor in any manner however made
him Satisfaction for the same altho' the said David hath been thereto
required by the said John afterwards (to wit) on the first day of
June in the year above mentioned & often afterwards at Somerset
County aforesaid; But the said David hitherto hath & still doth refuse
so to do; whereupon his the said John saith that he is thereby injured
& damaged to the value of thirty pounds and therefore bring suit &
