Whereupon the said David Smith in his own proper ^{Prison} cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when & where saith that he cannot gainway this action ^{Prison} of the afd. John Williams nor can he say but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid John Williams doth against him hath complained and as to the damages of the said John Williams by him by Occasion of the promises in that part sustained the said David Smith saith and confesseth that the afd. John Williams hath sustained damages by Occasion of the promises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part Amounted to Nineteen Pounds Six Shillings and Seven pence Current money of Maryland and not more and because the afd. John Williams deny not this but the said allegation confesseth to be true prays Judgment for those damages above confessed together with his Costs and Charges afd. to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties afd. it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid John Williams recover against the afd. David Smith damages afd. to the afd. Nineteen pounds six Shillings and Seven pence ^{Current money of Maryland} in form afd. Confessed as also ^{from hundred & nine} pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges afd. to the said John Williams by the Court here and Consent of the parties afd. adjudged and the afd. defendant in money &c.
