each of their goods, and Chattells Lands and tenements severally to be made and Levied to the use of his
said Lordship to be made and Levied if it happen that the said Isaac Moor do not make his
personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing
Bcale the third Tuesday of August next and do not answer unto his Lordship of and concerning
what shall be object'd against him on his said Lordships behalfe and do not stand & abide the Judg-
ment of the Court thereupon and do depart the same Court without leave therof and in the meane-
time if he is not of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all his good people & more spe-
cially towards the afo^d William Minter the —

a certain Frances Johnson a poor blind woman at such necessary as may be sufficient to support her in
his/her poor condition and see she or they to be allowed for the same at the next Levy Court and the

Whereas a certain John Lamberson of Somerset County planter being brought into this Court as witness
to be sworn on behalfe of his Lordship against a certain Thomas Lambden to the grand Jury and for
as much as the said John Lamberson did make use of, and was guilty of indecent behaviour to
the Court this sitting the said John Lamberson is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of
Somerset County therto remain & the said Sheriff to will Joseph McFester by Littleton Townsend
his Deputy present here in Court took charge of the said John Lamberson accordingly afterwards
