Adams hath nothing to object wherefore he had not burnt the tob. &c. Therefore the said Edw. Adams is fined twenty shillings Court money by occasion of the premises &c.

Henry Newman being somoned to appear at this Court for not burning of tobacco according to act of assembly in such cases made and provided & and for as much as it doth not appear to the Court here that the said Henry Newman hath nothing to object wherefore he had not burnt ^{the} tob. &c. Therefore the said Henry Newman is fined twenty shillings Court money by occasion of the premises &c.

Jeremiah Cary being somoned to appear at this Court for not burning of tobacco according to act of assembly in such cases made and provided & and for as much as it doth not appear to the Court here that the said Jeremiah Cary hath nothing to object wherefore he had not burnt the tob. &c. Therefore the said Jeremiah Cary is fined twenty shillings Court money by occasion of the premises &c.

Edward Beacock being somoned to appear at this Court for not burning of tobacco according to act of assembly in such cases made and provided & and for as much as it doth not appear to the Court here that the said Edward Beacock hath nothing to object wherefore he had not burnt the tob. &c. Therefore the said Edward Beacock is fined twenty shillings Court money by occasion of the premises &c. and thereupon the said Edw. Beacock present here in Court is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remain until he satisfies the fine &c. and all the other fees due by occasion of the premises &c.

Ann Jones being somoned to appear at this Court for not burning of tobacco according to act of assembly in such cases made and provided & and for as much as it doth appear to the Court here that the said Ann Jones hath nothing to object wherefore she had not burnt the tob. &c. Therefore the said Ann Jones is fined twenty shillings Court money by occasion of the premises &c.

Matthias Coston being somoned to appear at this Court for not burning of tobacco according to act of assembly in such cases made and provided & and for as much as it doth not appear to the Court here that the said Matthias Coston hath nothing to object wherefore he had not burnt the tob. &c. Therefore the said Matthias Coston is fined twenty shillings Court money by occasion of the premises &c. and thereupon the said Matthias Coston present here in Court is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of
