(to wit) the aforesaid thirteenth day of July Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred thirty and two aforesaid at Somerset County aforesaid & within the same aforesaid upon himself did assume & to the said John White then and there faithfully did promise to pay to him the aforesaid fourteen hundred Cyprus boards according to the tenor of the same note Nevertheless the aforesaid John Lamberson his promise and assumption as aforesaid inform aforesaid made nothing regarding but plotting & fraudulently intending the aforesaid John White in that part craftily & subtily to deceive and defraud the aforesaid fourteen hundred Cypress Board or any part thereof to the same John White hath not as yet been paid or him for the same in any sort contented altho' the same to do the aforesaid John Lamberson afterwards (to wit) the same day & year got the place last above mentioned and often afterwards by the said John White was requested but the same to him hitherto to pay or for the same in any sort to content & satisfy the said John Lamberson hath altho' others refused and still doth refuse and deny to the damage of him the said John White Ten pounds current money of Maryland and thereof he brings Suit & — Pledges Doff Int. Whereupon the said John Lamberson present herein Court in his proper person is by the same Court adjudged to give special bail to this action aff'd Thereupon a certain Edward Cluff of Somerset County Blacksmith came herein to Court in his proper person and undertook for the said John Lamberson and assumed upon himself (Likewise the said John Lamberson assumed upon himself) that if in case the said John White should recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said John Lamberson or that the said John Lamberson should be therewith convicted that then he the said John Lamberson should pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his body in execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that his said Edward Cluff will do the same for him & —

And the aforesaid John Lamberson by George Douglas his attorney general cometh and defendeth the same and Injury wherein & and prays leave therefore to appear hereuntill next Court and his shall it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John White heralso & —

Att which said next Court to wit the Nineteenth day of August Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and thirty five came again as well the aforesaid John White as the aforesaid John Lamberson by their attorneys aff'd and whereupon the same John Lamberson prays further leave the same to appear hereuntill next Court and his shall it and the same day is given unto the aforesaid John White heralso & —

Att which said next Court to wit the Eighteenth day of November Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and thirty five came again as well the aforesaid John White as the aforesaid John Lamberson by their attorneys aff'd
