At the which said next Court to wit the Eighteenth day of November Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty five came againe as well the aff[or] John Maglaughlin as the aff[or] William Robinson by their attorneys aff[or] and because the aforesaid John Maglaughlin did not declare against the aforesaid William Robinson in the plea aforesaid - Therefore he and his pledges of prosecuting be in mercy and that the plaintife name Pledge &c. and that the aforesaid William Robinson recover against the aforesaid John Maglaughlin his damages by Occasion of the promises to. Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Rebecca Obyan late of Somerset County Spinster if she should be found in his Bailly: wick and here should safe here so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August there next to answer unto Thomas Fletcher and Sarah his wife of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. And that they of his should not fail &c.
