mitteth the said John Woolford by William Beckingham his attorney and the Sheriff
of Somerset County to withdrawe from his Castle Grounds the same day came
and makes return that he had taken the said James Duffey and him detained in
custody to satisfy the said John Woolford his debt and damages aff^d as by the pre-
cept aff^d he was commanded &^t Whereupon the said Sheriff to wit Joseph M^rester
Gent^t at the same day altho' solemnly called being not in the body of the
said James Duffey according to the return of his writ aforesaid but makes
