their body's goods or Chattells Lands and tenements to be made and Levied to the Use of the
Said George Givans his heirs and assigns If it happen that the said Edward Rownd
doe not comply with the Law in relation to such Guardianship, as aforesaid and do not deliver
up unto the sd. George Givans all his Estate both Real and personall that he received into
his hands and possession peaceably and quietly when ever the same shall be Legally required &
