Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Betty Game be thereat acquitted & goe thro' of without day &c. Likewise it is considered that the said Betty Game give security for the payment of the severall officers their fees due by occasion of the premises &c & that the said Mr. Justice of Somerset County Court present heron Court undertook for the said Betty Game to pay the severall officers fees due by means of the premises &c

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Abraham Heath if he to answer &c and afterwards to wit the sixteenth day of March anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held at Dwiding Creek in the same County came the said Abraham Heath in his own proper person and had hearing of the presentment &c and being instantly demanded how he would acquit himselfe of the premises &c above upon him imposed ... with that of the premises &c above upon him imposed with that he is guilty thereof ... whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here being seen heard and fully understood &c. It is considered by the Court here that the said Abraham Heath pay unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court here upon him imposed for and by occasion of the trespass and assault aforsaid whereof in form &c he is convicted two shillings and sixpence current money of Maryland & that the said Abraham Heath be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of this fine &c and is discharged paying of fees &c

Thereupon the said John Deal and Thomas Blizard's appearances are leaved and they and their securitys are accordingly discharged

Whereupon the said John Deal and Thomas Blizard are ordered to give recognizance in thirty pounds Sterling each for their good behaviour and appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwiding Creek the third Tuesday of June next

whereupon
