Whereupon the said Timothy Hale is ordered to give Security for the payment of his severall Officers fees due by reason of his felony on the Indictment &c but for want thereof the said Timothy Hale is committed into the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County to remand him the said Sher. to wit Joseph M'Gester gent. by Francis Carter his deputy present here in Court took charge of the said Timothy Hale accordingly the
