Whereupon all and Singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood... It seems to the Court here that the aforesaid pair of Boots, Red Riding Coat and pair of Stockings are all of the value of four hundred and Twenty pounds of Gold.

Thereupon it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Jeremiah Lilley pay unto Joseph M^r Gester the party dequided four pound of the value of the goods aforesaid Stolen amounting in the whole to Sixteen hundred and Eighty pounds of Robans and that the said Jeremiah Lilley be whipt at the public whipping post with fifteen Stripes on the bare Back well laid on untill the blood appear and that he stand immediately in the pillowry one quarter of an hour and that he be taken &c. and thereupon as to the Corporal punishment aforesaid command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do therof immediately by whom according to the Judgment aforesaid Rendered by whipping of the aforesaid Jeremiah Lilley at the public whipping post with fifteen Stripes on the bare Back well laid on untill the blood appear and by putting him in the pillowry one quarter of an hour and aforesaid afterwards in the same Court came the said Sheriff and made a return that he had done the Execution of the Judgment aforesaid as to the Corporal punishment aforesaid he was commanded &c.

Wherefore it is considered and ordered by the Court here that the Sher. of Somerset County to witt Joseph M^r Gester have sold the aforesaid Jeremiah Lilley - Immediately to the Biggest Bidder not exceeding seven year towards Satisfaction of the four pound aforesaid and the several Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid - afterwards in the same Court came the said Sheriff and made Return to the Court here that he had sold the said Jeremiah Lilley unto a certain James Collett the Biggest Bidder for one thousand pounds of Robans, for seven years to commence from the day of the date of these presents &c. towards Satisfaction of the four pound and the several Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid &c.
