Ordered by the Billa vera B. Hough foreman.

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he Should take the Said Daniel Rhodes if he to answer the same and afterward to wit the Sixteenth day of March and anno One thousand Seven hundred and Thirly five before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held at Dwidning Creek in and for the same County came the said Daniel Rhodes in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance by him and his Surety before acknowledged and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid and being instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the premises aforesaid upon him imposed, says that of the premises aforesaid upon him imposed he is guilty thereof and is willing to pay his fine for the same aforesaid whereupon all and Singular the premises by the Court hee seen heard and fully understood. It is Considered by the Justices here that the said Daniel Rhodes pay unto his Lordship His Right honble His Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court imposed upon him imposed whereof in summe aforesaid he is comittid Thirly shillings curr. money of Maryland for the use of the County and that the said Daniel Rhodes be taken to Satisfie his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid Whereupon the said Daniel Rhodes is ordered by the Court to give security to save and keep Indemnified the Justices of Somerset County and their Successors for the time being from all costs charges trouble and Burthen that might accrue by the means of the birth of a bastard child lately begot and born of the body of Margaret Causay. &c.

Thereupon the said Daniel Rhodes with James Givens of Somerset County planter his Surety both present herein and in their proper persons acknowledged god to witness with thirly pounds Sterling each of their goods and chattels Lands and tenements to the use of the County of Somerset to be used and levied If it happen that the said Daniel Rhodes his Sons Executors and Administrators or any of them do and shall not from time to time and at all times forever hereafter acquit discharge and Save harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County Court and their Successors as also the Inhabitants of the same County from all costs charges and trouble what soever for or by reason of the birth maintenance Nururisng and bringing up of the said child and of and from all other suits Proceedings and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the
