Likewise that said Daniel Rhodes is ordered to give Security for the payment of the several Officers their fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid - & though on the said Daniel Rhodes present here in Court acknowledged himself Indebted in ten pounds to his Lordship to be levied. If it happen that the said Daniel Rhodes do not pay unto the several Officers their fees due on the said Indictment by occasion of the premises aforesaid

His Lordship . . . Somerset County The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is for the body of Somerset County as a Joseph Bishop . . . upon their Oath do swear that Joseph Bishop late of all hallow parish in the County of . . . planter the twenty fourth day of February in the Year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred thirty and five at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain William Selby (the same, William, Selby then and there being Constable of Mattopory hundred in the County aforesaid duly appointed and qualified and in the Execution of his said office of Constable of the said hundred then being in the peace of God and of the said Lord Proprietary then and there being with Force and arms an assault did make and him the said William Selby then and there did beat wound and evilly tract so that of his Life it was much despaired and other harm to him then and there did to the great damage of the same William and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good Duke and Government &c.

Test William Selby Juror. On the back side of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was thus Endorsed vizt Edmund Hough foreman.

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Joseph Bishop if he to answer &c. and afterwards to wit the Sixteenth day of March anno. Dom. One thousand seven hundred and thirty five Before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset now here hold at Widwisp Creek in and for the same County came the said Joseph Bishop in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance by him and his Security before acknowledged and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid, who thereupon says that of the premises aforesaid as by the Indictment aforesaid above upon him is Imposed he is guilty thereof.

Whereupon albeit singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood It is Considered by the Justices here that the said Joseph Bishop pay to his Lordship the legal sum to the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court hereupon him Imposed for and by occasion of the the trespass and assault aforesaid whereof in form aforesaid he is Convict twenty Shillings current money of Maryland and that the said Joseph Bishop be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid. Whereupon the said Joseph Bishop is ordered to give Security for his good behaviour and appearance at June Court next &c. Thereupon the said Joseph Bishop with Isaac Brittingham his Security both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted
