Thereupon a certain Thomas Williams of Somerset County Gent present here in Court in his proper person and undertakes for the said John Williams according to act of assembly that in case the said Martin Genton do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said John Williams his Claim against him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the Laying of the attachment ~~and~~ that then he the said John Williams shall make restitution unto the said Martin Genton of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c or that he the said Thomas Williams will do it for him &c

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the severall goods and Chattells so as aforesaid attached of the value of forty four pounds Nine shillings Court money of Maryland be condemned in the hands of the said John Williams as of the goods and Chattells of the said Martin Genton towards Satisfying unto the said John Williams his damages ~~and~~ and all costs and Charges recovered against him by way of attachment and that the said John Williams have thereof Execution &c
