And whereupon the said John Bell in his proper person cometh and defendeth the said and Jur- jury when & saith that he cannot gainway the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Francis Porter nor can he say but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Francis Porter above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Francis Porter by him by Omission of the premises in that part sustained the same John Bell saith & Confesseth that the aforesaid Francis Porter hath sustained Damages by Omission of the premises further than his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part apposed to three pounds ten Shillings Curr. money of Maryland and not more and because the same Francis Porter deny, not this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true pray Judgment for those Damages above Confessed together with his Costs and Charges up to him to be ad judged &c

Therefore by Consent of the parties and it is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Francis Porter recover against the aforesaid John Bell his Damages aforesaid to the aforesaid three pounds ten Shillings Curr. money of Maryland in full and Confessed as also Two hundred & thirty four pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges up to the same Francis Porter by the Court here and Consent of the parties and ad judged and the aforesaid defend. in manner &c
