And whereupon the said John Bell in his pro per person cometh and defendeth the same and In-  
jury where he and saith that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Francis Borter nor  
can he say but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Francis Borter above  
against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Francis Borter by him by reason of the  
premises which part sustained the same John Bell saith & confesseth that the aforesaid Francis Borter  
hath sustained damages by reason of the premises further than his costs and charges by him about his suit  
in that part opposed to three pounds ten shillings curr. money of Maryland and not more and because the  
same Francis Borter denys not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true pray Judgment for those  
damages above confessed together with his costs and charges up to sum to be adjudged &

Therefore by consent of the parties as it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid  
Francis Borter recover against the aforesaid John Bell his damages aforesaid to the aforesaid three  
Pounds ten Shillings curr. money of Maryland in form aforesaid Confessed as also Two hundred & thirty  
four p<sup>o</sup>unds curr. money of Maryland for his costs and charges aforesaid to the same Francis Borter  
by the Court here and consent of the parties as adjudged and the aforesaid defendant in every other
