At W^t Isaiah Bradale Comand was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he shoule have
t^d Samuel Hale = Samuel Hale late of Somerset County planter ad d^d Samuel Hale of Somerset
County in the province of Maryland planter if he shoule be found in his Bailewicke
and hui shoule safe keepe so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of
Somerset to be hold at Widning Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto Isaiah Bradale
of agise that he lende unto hui nineteen pounds and ten pence Court money of Maryland whiche to him he
owes and unjustly detaines &c and that hys of he shoule not fail.

And the said Isaiah Bradale by Francis Allen his attorney declered against the said Samuel Hale in
the plen off as followeth vizt.

Somerset County vsd Samuel Hale late of Somerset County planter ad d^d Samuel Hale of Somerset
County in the province of Maryland planter was somonied to answer unto Isaiah Bradale of agise
that he lende unto hui nineteen pounds and ten pence Court money of Maryland whiche to him he
owes and unjustly detaines &c.

And whereupon the said Isaiah by Francisco Allen his attorney saith that
whereas the said Samuell the seventeenth day of Febyr. Sevebteene hundred
thirty four sueat Somerset County ad within the Term of this Court by
his certian wrighting obligatorie which the said Isaiah with the seal
of the said Samuell Agreed hereinto Court bringes the date whereof is
the same day of year did acknowledge himself to be bound unto the said
Isaiah in the afof nineteen pounds and ten pence money afof to be paid
unto the said Isaiah when he shoule be thereunto required yet the said
Samuell therof often required the said nineteen pounds and ten pence to
the said Isaiah hath not rendered but the same to him hitherto Rendered hath
denyd and still doth deny and unjustly retain to the damage of the said
Isaiah of fifteen pounds money afof And thereupon he bring Sute vsd
pledge def^d I^r Joe Rose
