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Special Bail to the action of ... Whereupon a certain Richard Hickman and Francis Wharton both of Somerset County planters came here into Court in their proper persons and undertook and each of them undertook and assumed upon themselves (likewise the said Samuel Hall assumed upon himself) that if in case the said Isaiah Bredale should recover Judgment in the plea of against the said Samuel Hall or that the said Samuel Hall should be therein convicted that then he the said Samuel Hall shall pay the condemnation of the Court thereupon or lend or his body in execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that they the said Richard Hickman and Francis Wharton or either of them will do the same for him &c.

And whereupon the said Samuel Hall by George Douglas his attorney said cometh and defendeth the free and injury whereof and the said attorney says that he is not informed by the said Samuel Hall his client of any answer for the said Samuel to the aforesaid Isaiah in the plea of to be given and nothing else thereof says by which the said Isaiah remaineth against the said Samuel thereof undefended

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Isaiah Bredale Recover against the said Samuel Hall his debt of and his damages by occasion of the Detention of that same debt to four hundred & Eleven pounds of Tobacco to the said Isaiah of his assent by the Court here adjudged and the said debt in money &c.

At John Reddish His Lordship the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland Commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County by his writ in these words following vizt. — Somerset County p. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we Command you that you attach any the goods Chattels rights or Credits of John Wilcox late of Somerset County planter if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of fifty six shillings and three pence Curr. money of Maryland and six hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and when you have the same, attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing the third Tuesday of March Next, there and there to be, condemned according to act, of Assembly and for the use of John Reddish towards satisfying unto the said John Reddish fifty six shillings and three pence Curr. money and two hundred and ninety two pounds of tobacco which to the said John Reddish in our Court (before)
