

before our Justices at Winding Creek in the same County were adjudged for his damage which he had by reason of the non performance of a certain promise and assumption made and not performed & that by good and lawfully men of your Bailiwick you shall take knowledge unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels rights or Credits so attached in his or there hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to act of asembly in such case made and provided) if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writ witness Robert King Esq. Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty seventh day of November in the twenty first year of our Dominion. And Done one thousand, seven hundred, and thirty five.

At which said third Tuesday of March being the sixteenth day of the same month and Done one thousand seven hundred and thirty five being the day of the return of the same writ came the said John Reddish in his proper person and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise came and made return thereof to the Court here before and I certify that by virtue of the within writ attached of the goods and Chattels of the within John Wilcox to the value of the sum within mentioned and them have delivered to the within named John Reddish in satisfaction thereof so answers Jos. M. Carter Esq.

Whereupon the said John Reddish by Francis Allen his Attorney came here into Court and prayed that the aforesaid goods and Chattels so as aforesaid attached of the value of the sum aforesaid may be condemned as the goods and Chattels of the said John Wilcox towards satisfying unto the said John Reddish his damages and costs aforesaid.

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the aforesaid goods and Chattels so as aforesaid attached of the value of the sum aforesaid be condemned as the goods and Chattels of the said John Wilcox towards satisfying unto the said John Reddish of his damages aforesaid and costs aforesaid as also all costs accruing by means of the writ of attachment aforesaid and that those of us have his Honour's command to act of Chamberlain.
