the Estate of the said John Nelson both Real and personale and Likewise that he give Security for to
Comply with the Guardianship aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said James Martini with William Lane of Somerset County Gents his security both
present before Court in their proper persons and acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Executors
the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary in the sum of forty pounds Sterling each of their bodys goods
or Chattels Lands or tenements severally to be made and Levied to the Use of the said John Nelson his
heirs and assigns If it happen that the said James Martini do not Comply with the Law in relation
to such Guardianship as aforesaid and do not deliver up unto the said John Nelson all his Estate
both Real and personale (that he shall take into his hands and possession) peaceably and quietly
whenever the same shall be Legally required &c.

County until he arrives at the age of twenty one year he being fifteen years
of age in October next the said Nathaniel Morris to serve his said Master the full term of time &c.

During which term the said Nathaniel Morris his said Master well and faithfully shall serve his service
Keep his Commandments Lawfully and honestly every where willingly he shall do and in all things as a
good and faith full apprentice shall demean himself towards his said Master and all his during the term
aforesaid In consideration of which service the said James Longo present before Court in his proper
person Covenanteth with the Justice of the same Court in manner and form following vizt. that he the
said James Longo during the term &c shall and will Learn the said Nathaniel Morris his apprentice to
make Linnen and wollen whels and Cranes and to read well in the bible and to write and at the
expiration of his service give him anew Suit of Cloathes over and above his Common wearing Cloathes &
Likewise provide for his said apprentice meet drink washing Lodging and Cloathing sufficient for
such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c.
