can he say but that the writing Obligatory afo is his deed nor but that he owes the same Jacob the afo Seven pounds Cent
money in manner and form as the afo Jacob above against him hath declared wherof the same Jacob prays Judgment
for his debt afo and his damages sustained by reason of the detention of the same debt to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the afo Jacob Hammond recover against the afo said
William Stevens his debt afo and his damages sustained by reason of the detention of that same debt
pounds of Tobacco by the Court here unto the said

Rt Jacob Cullen } Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Peter
for Peter Frazer } Frazer late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailly with and him.

Should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Majesty's County Court of
Somerset to be held at Durdunig Green the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto Jacob Cullen of afo
of trespass upon the Case &c. and that thereafter he should not fail &c.

And the said Jacob Cullen by Robert Dencham Henry his attorney complained against the said Peter
Frazer in the plea afo as followeth vid.

Somerset sh. Peter Frazer late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto Jacob Cullen
of afo of trespass upon the Case &c.

And whereupon the same Jacob by Robert Dencham Henry his attorney complained that whereas
the afo Peter after the first day of May Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and six to wit
the ninth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred
thirty five and six at Somerset County afo (within the Jurisdiction of this Court) made his cer-
tain Note in writing commonly called a promissory note with his proper hand thereunto
subscribed bearing date the same day and year last above mentioned which said
note the afo Peter to the same Jacob then and there did deliver and by the same
note he did oblige himself to pay or cause to be paid to the afo Jacob by the name of
Jacob Cullen the sum or Quantity of two Barrells of good merchantable pork upon
demand, and Two Shillings and Six pence in money for value received (as by the
said Note hereinto Court brought may appear) by reason of which said promise
and also by force of the Statute in such case thereof made and provided the same
Peter became chargeable to pay to the same Jacob the afo Two Barrells of good Mer-
chantable pork and Two Shillings and Six pence in money upon demand according
to the Tenor of the same note and the afo Peter thereof being chargeable in consideration
thereof afterwards (to wit) the same day and year last above mentioned at Somerset
Court
