

Peter Fraser in his proper person Cometh and defendeth the same and Injury. when &c. and saith that he cannot gain say the action afo of the afo Jacob Cullen nor can he say but that he did asume upon himself in manner and form as the afo Jacob Cullen above against him hath Complaind and as to the Damage of him the same Jacob Cullen by him by Omission of the premises in that part sustained the same Peter saith and Confesseth that the afo Jacob Cullen hath Sustained Damages by Omission of the premises further than his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part apposed to two Barrells of good merchantable Cork and two shillings & Six pence Curr. money and not more and because the afo Jacob says not this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true foray Judgment for those Damages afo above Comfessed together with his Costs and charges afo to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is Considered by the Court here that the afo Jacob Cullen recover against the afo Peter Fraser his Damages afo to the afo Two Barrells of good merchantable Cork and two shillings and Six pence Curr. money in form afo Comfessed as also pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charge aforesaid to the same Jacob Cullen by the Court here and Consent of the parties afo adjudged and the afo Debt in money &c.
