unto Joseph Ward until she arrives at the age of sixteen years she being
seven years of age last February the said Ann Adams to serve her said Master the full term of
during which term the said Ann Adams her said Master well and faithfully shall serve his secrets
keep his commandments Lawfully and honestly every where willingly she shall do and in all things
as a good and faithful apprentice shall demean herself towards her said Master and all his during
the term of ye. In consideration of which service the said Joseph Ward present here in Court
in his proper person Covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court in manner and form following
that is to say that he the said Joseph Ward during the term aforesaid shall and will learn his
said apprentice to read well in the Bible and to knit sew and spin and other housewifery and when
his said apprentice shall arrive at the age of fourteen years give her a young ewe of about
three years old and at the expiration of her servitude give her a new suit of Cloaths over and
above her common wearing Cloaths and likewise provide for his said apprentice meal drink
washing Dyeing and Bathing mete for her to have and wear during the term of ye

Upon this the said Joseph Ward is ordered to give security for to comply with the Covenant,
And upon the said Joseph Ward with Rendall Smullen of Somerset County planter his
security both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted
unto the said Ann Adams in five pounds Sterling each of their bodies goods or Chattels Lands or
tenements severally to be made and Levied to the use of the said Ann Adams her heirs or assigns
If it happen that the said Joseph Ward do not during the term of learn his said apprentice to
read well in the Bible and to knit sew and spin and other housewifery and do not give unto his said
apprentice when she shall arrive at the age of fourteen a young ewe of about three years old and at
the expiration of her servitude do not give her a new suit of Cloaths over and above her common
wearing Cloaths and do not provide for his said apprentice during the term of Meal drink
washing Dyeing and Bathing mete for such an apprentice to have & wear
