

aforsaid and whereupon the same Thomas Gray by his said attorney as before said the force and injury when & saith that he cannot give way the action of the said Thomas Nevell nor can he say but that the same Thomas Gray did assume upon himself in manner and form as the same Thomas Nevell above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Thomas Nevell by him by reason of the premises in that part sustained the same Thomas Gray saith and confesseth that the said Thomas Nevell hath sustained damages by reason of the premises and further than his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to fifteen pounds fifteen shillings and three pence sterling and not more and because the said Thomas Nevell denies not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true prays Judgment for those damages above confessed together with his costs and charges and to him to be adjudge &c

Therefore by Consent of the parties and it is considered by the Court here that the said Thomas Nevell recover against the aforsaid Thomas Gray his damages aforsaid to the said fifteen pounds fifteen shillings and three pence sterling in full and confessed as above from hundred and seventy four pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges and to the same Thomas Nevell by the Court here and Consent of the parties and adjudge and the said Thomas Gray in mercy &c

was attached to answer unto William Turpin Junr of plea of trespass

And whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas the said Godfrey the twenty ninth day of March seventeen hundred and thirty four in consideration that he the said William on the first day of November seventeen hundred and thirty four did hire and lett out to the said Godfrey at the special Instance and request of him the said Godfrey a negroe man named Jacob which said negroe man did remain in the service & Employment of the said Godfrey from the 5th day of November in the year af until the twenty ninth day of March Anno Dom seventeen hundred and thirty five the said Godfrey in consideration that he the said William at the special Instance and request of him the said Godfrey would permit and suffer the said negroe Jacob further to remain in the service and Employment of him the said Godfrey after the said twenty ninth day of March in the year last af until the full term of six months from the 5th day of November seventeen hundred thirty four should be well and truly compleat and ended upon himself did assume and to the said William then and there did faithfully promise that he the said Godfrey for the service of the said negroe for the time af one thousand pounds of Tobacco to the said William after the service af performed when he should be thereunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and content and the said William in fact saith that giving credit to the promise and assumption af of the said Godfrey he did permit and suffer the said negroe Jacob to remain in (the)
