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The aforesaid Day in the sum of four pounds four Shillings and ten pence (four money of Maryland) for divers Goods wares and Merchandizes by the aforesaid Day unto the aforesaid William Wye at his special Instance and Request before that time there sold and delivered as by an Account thereof here in Court ready to be produced may appear And whereas of being Indebted the aforesaid William Wye afterwards to wit the aforesaid twenty first day of January in the year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred and thirty four at the County aforesaid in consideration thereof upon himself did assume and unto the same Day then and there faithfully did promise that he the aforesaid William Wye the aforesaid sum of money unto the aforesaid Day when thereof afterward he should be required well and faithfully pay and content Nevertheless the aforesaid William Wye his promise and assumption of nothing regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the aforesaid Day in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid sum of money or any part thereof unto the same day hath not paid nor for the same in any sort (contented) altho' to do the same by the aforesaid Day afterwards to wit the tenth Day of August in the year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred and thirty five at Somerset County aforesaid the aforesaid William Wye was required but that unto him hitherto pay or in any sort to content altogether hath refused and still refuse to the Damage of the same Day nine pounds like money and five hundred pounds of Tobacco And thereupon he bringeth suit &c.
