Francis Allen late of Somerset County Gent. and undertook for the same Robert Geddes and assumed upon himself
[Likewise the said Robert Geddes assumed upon himself] that if in the said George Bouds should be
in Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said Robert Geddes or that the said Robert Geddes should
be therein convicted that then he the said Robert Geddes should pay the Judgment of the Court thereon or ransom
his body ~~and~~ ^{and} ~~to the~~ ^{to the} ~~prison~~ ^{prison} of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfac-
tion thereof that he the said Francis Allen will do the same for him &c

And whereupon the said Robert Geddes by William Buckingham his attorney comes and defends the force
and injury sheweth and prays Leave thereof to appear hereunto next Court and he hath it and the same
day is given to the said George Bouds to do also &c

At which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of March Anno Dom. One thousand Seven
hundred and thirty five came again as well the said George Bouds as the said Robert Geddes by their
attorneys &c and whereupon the same Robert as before defends the force and injury when he
and saith that he did not assume upon himself in such manner and form as the said
George above against him hath declared and therefore put himself upon the Country
and the jury Likewise

Whereupon after wards the Sunday and Year Last above mentioned came hereunto Court the said
Robert Geddes by his attorney &c and upon him the same Robert relinquisheth his Verification by
him above alleged and saith that he cannot gainway the action &c of the said George Bouds nor can he
say but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said George above against him --
hath complained, and as to the damage of the same George by him by Question of the premises in
that part sustained the same Robert saith and confesseth that the said George hath sustained --
damages by Question of the premises further than his costs and charges by him about his Suit in that
part assessed to five pounds ten Shillings Curr. money of Maryland and not more and because
the said George says not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true pray Judgment for
those damages above confessed together with his costs and charges &c to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore by Consent of the parties &c it is considered by the Court here that
the said George Bouds recover against the aforesaid Robert Geddes his damages &c to the said
five pounds ten Shillings Curr. money of Maryland in full as confessed as also
costs of Robt for his costs and charges &c to the
same George Bouds of this spent by the Court here adjudged with Day of Execution until the
Eighteenth day of April next and the said Robert in money &c
