Date the 27th Day of November 1735 Impowering us to examine Evidence in Relation to the Bound of a certain Tract of Land called maidens Lott in the possession of John Gillis in compliance whereof after having given public notice according to act of assembly on the fifteenth day of Jan^y 1735/6 we met on the said Land to Execute the said Commission and the following deposition was Taken Before us James Caldwell

The deposition of John Wilson aged fifty one years or there about being sworn deposeseth and sayeth that about twenty years by past his father old Thomas Wilson Told him that there was a Bounder of maidens Lott standing near the wading place of Barran Creek and further sayeth not

The deposition of William Young aged forty eight years or there about being sworn on the holy Evangelist of almighty God deposeseth and saith that about thirty years by past this Depoⁿant's Mother was possessor of a tract of Land called Wilsons mistake and John Leverton who was owner of a Tract of Land called maidens Lott agreed to Joyn their pasture fences and each of them was to set as far as their one Land went and Joyn on the division and in order to know where the division was ^{this} Depoⁿant sayeth that the as^t John Leverton Took a pocket Compass and went to a white Oak standing about thirty eight yards below the wading place of Barran Creek marked with sixteen notches by the path side and said that that tree was the Division Between the Depoⁿant's mother and him and run a line from the said tree for the division and accordingly they Joyned their fence on the line this Depoⁿant further sayeth that sometime after he the Depoⁿant was possessor of the Land called Wilsons mistake and that he never claimed or sold any Land below the Bounder before mentioned but always allowed that tree to be the division between the two tracts and understood it to be the second Bounder of maidens Lott and further sayeth not

The deposition of Solomon Right Aged thirty one years or there about being sworn deposeseth and sayeth that about four years by past he the Depoⁿant was taken with his father old Edward Right concerning the Bounders of a tract of Land called Wilsons mistake and that his father told him that the first Bounder of the as^t tract of Land stood on the wading place point and that it was either a stooping tree or a forked tree and further sayeth not
