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that there of he should not fail to. At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the Eighteenth day of the same month and Year One thousand Seven hundred & thirty five being the day of the Return of the said Writ Cometh the said John Apsou by Thomas Blythe his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh return hereof to the Court her Endorsed in those words following VIZ -

Legi Coram Joseph M. Foster Shes

Whereupon Came here into Court the said Ann Draper in her proper person and thereupon at the prayer of the said John Apsou by his attorney of the said Ann Draper is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action aforesaid. Whereupon a certain William Draper late of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Ann Draper and assumed upon himselfe [Likewise the said Ann Draper assumed upon herselfe] that if in Case the said John Apsou should recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said Ann Draper or that the said Ann Draper should be therein found that then she the said Ann Draper should pay the Judgment of the Court thereon or tender her body in execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction hereof or that he the same William Draper will do the same for her.

Whereupon the said Ann Draper doth of the same Alexander Draper do by Robert Jankin Henry her attorney Cometh and saving to herselfe all manner of advantages to the writt aforesaid prays leave thereof to imparte hereunto the next Court and she hath it & the same day is given to the said John here also &c.

At which said next Court to wit the Sixteenth day of March and Year One thousand Seven hundred and thirty five Came again as well the said John Apsou as the aforesaid Ann Draper by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said John Apsou then and there his writt aforesaid against the said Ann Draper did not prosecute with effect but voluntarily committed his Suit to be discontinued -

Therefore afterwards to wit the second day by direction of the Justices here were adjudged the same Ann Draper doth of the said Alexander Draper pounds of tobacco for her Costs and Charges by her about her Defense in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute in such Case lately made and provided & the said John in Mery and that the said Ann have thereof Execution &c.

Peter Frazer of Somerset County being summoned to appear at this Court to answer his not Burning of tobacco according to act of assembly in such Case made and provided (75)
