Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Robert Denniston pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid to twenty Shillings Curr. money of Maryland and that he be taken &c.

Hurman Odear of Somerset County planter came here into Court in his proper person according to certain Writs of attachment that had issued against him and his now wife lately called Rosa Freeman for not appearing last November Court to answer their and each of their not burning of tobacco according to act of assembly in such case made and provided and forasmuch as the said Hurman Odear had nothing to object that was material wherefore they had not burnt the tobacco according to Law, wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Hurman Odear pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid Twenty Shillings Curr. money of Maryland Likewise that he pay unto his said Lordship for his wife's fine for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid Twenty Shillings Curr. money of Maryland and that the said Hurman Odear be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid and the several officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid. Whereupon the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit Joseph McCarter Gent. by Joseph Merrill his deputy present took charge of the said Hurman Odear accordingly &c.

Benjamin Shanks of Somerset County planter came here into Court in his proper person according to a certain Writ of attachment against him issued for not appearing at November Court last to answer his not burning of tobacco according to act of assembly in such case made and provided and forasmuch as the said Benjamin Shanks had nothing to object that was material wherefore he had not burnt his tobacco according to Law but was willing to pay his fine for the same &c. Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Benjamin Shanks pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid Forty Shillings Curr. money of Maryland and that he be taken &c.
