Whereupon It is Ordered by the Court here that Abraham Benjamin Givans of Somerset County  
planter deliver up unto the said Guardian all the Estate of the said George Givans that he hath  
in his hands or possession both Real and personall and that the said Guardian Receive the  
same &c. And Likewise it is Ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Guardian give  
Security for to comply with the Guardianship aforesaid &c

Thereupon the said Edward Rownd with Isaac Standy of Somerset County Gentleman Security  
both present herein Court with their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto  
the said George Givans in the sum of One hundred pounds sterling Each of their body's goods  
or Chattels Land or tenements severally to be made and Levied to the Use of the said George Givans  
his heirs or assigns If it happen that the said Edward Rownd do not comply with the Law in  
relation to the Guardianship aforesaid and do not deliver up unto the said George Givans all his Estate  
both Real and personall (that he shall take into his hands and possession) peaceably and quietly  
whenever the same shall be Legally required &c

pet. } that your worships would be pleased to order that Andrew Smith overseer of  
the Chavannah Road may be obliged to Bear and maintain his load from Madam -

than now he is to Bear your petitioners Reason is because he expects an order of Court to Bear from -  
Robert Jarnans to the said Madam Hamptons plantation which is along way and very difficult to Bear

lawfully kept in order and people enough to do it he prays your worships consideration in the
