Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Dominick Haley late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of this Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto George Sharpe of ayles of trespass upon the Case &c. and that thereof he should not fail &c

And the said George Sharp by William Buckingham his attorney Complaines against the said Dominick Haley in the plea as followeth to wit

Somerset sh^d Dominick Haley late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto George Sharpe in ayles of trespass upon the Case &c

And whereupon the said George by William Buckingham his attorney Complaines that whereas the said Dominick the first day of August am^d D^d Seventeen hundred and thirty five at Somerset County sh^d Within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said George in five pounds sixteen Shillings and four pence half penny Curr^t money of Maryland for sundry properly chargeable in ar^t; as by an^d thereof here into annexed may in Court appear and being so those of Debted the said Dominick in consideration thereof the day and year afo at the place afo upon himselfe do assume and to the said George then and there did faithfully promise that he the said Dominick the said five pounds sixteen shillings and four pence half penny Curr^t money to the said George when he should be afterwards thereunto Requested he would well and faithfully pay and content Never the less the said Dominick his promise and assumption afo in form afo made nothing regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending the said George in that point Casually and Subtly to deceive and defraud the said five pounds sixteen shillings and four pence half penny to the said George altho the same to do the said Dominick by the said George on the first day of November in the year afo and often afterwards at the County of Somerset afo he was thereunto Requested hath not paid or contented but the same to him hitherto to pay hath refused and will both refuse and deny to the damage of the said George of Ten pounds Curr^t money afo and thereof he brings Suit &c
