sixteenth day of March in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and thirty
five before John Smith Gent. and his associates the said Lord Proprietary his Justices of
the same County Court and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give the same Justices hereto
understand and be informed that John Kenney late of Somerset County planter the tenth day
of January Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five at the parish a^s. in the
County a^s. within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Isaac Knott of the
same County Carpenter an assault did make and him then and there did beat wound and cruelly
treat so that of his life it was greatly despaired and other harms to him then and there did
