Thereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said
Daniel Co. if he to answer him afterward to wit the fifteenth day of June anno Domini One thousand
seven hundred and Ninety six before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here
held at Bridgwater in the same County came the said Daniel Co. in his proper person and had appear-
ing of the Judgment aforesaid who therupon saith that he is guilty thereof and is willing to pay his
fine for his fault aforesaid whereupon all and Singular the premises by his Court here seen heard and
fully understood It is considered by the Justices here that the said Daniel Co. pay unto his Lordships
the Lord Proprietary for his fine by his Court here upon sum imposed for and by Quanton of the pre-
mises aforesaid whereof in sum aforesaid he is bound Ninety Shillings Current money of Maryland and that the said

Daniel Co. be taken to Satisfaction his said Lordships of the sum aforesaid whereupon the said Daniel Co.
present herein Court is ordered to give security to two and keep Indemnified the Justices of Somerset County Court
and their Successors for the time being from all Costs Charges Troubles Burthenes that might accrue by means of the
birth maintenance and bringing up of a bastard Child lately begott of the body of the aforesaid Eliz. Bedward

Whereupon the said Daniel Co. with William Frasit and John Gales both of Somerset County planters his
security all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his said

Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of Ninety pounds sterl. good and lawfull money of England of their
severale body goods and Chattels Land and tenements to be made and levied to the use of the Justices of Somerset
County Court and their Successors if it happen that the said Daniel Co. for his birth aforesaid do and flente
not from time to time and at all times forever thereafter a quiet discharge and satisfaction as well the Justices
of Somerset County Court for the time being and their Successors as also the Inhabitants of the same County
from all Costs Charges and Troubles what so ever for or by reason of the birth maintenance Nourishing and
bringing up of the said Child and of and from all other such Costs Charges burthenes trouble and demands
what so ever touching or concerning of the same &c Likewise the said Daniel Co. is ordered to give security for
the payment of the severale Chars. he is bound due on the premises aforesaid Whereupon the said Wm Frasit for another
in Court and waies for the said Daniel Co. to pay all the fees due as aforesaid
