and assault aforesaid. While certain John Deal & Thomas Blizard then and there present herein Court aforesaid
prays themselves at fine with his said Lordship by Oath aforesaid and they are admitted and and there
of they severally put themselves in mercy of his said Lordship and the fine of the same John
Deal by the Justices here is assessed to thirty Shillings current money and the fine of the same Tho.
Blizard is assessed by the same Justices to thirty Shillings current money of Maryland to the use of his
said Lordship --- Whereupon the said Thomas Blizard is ordered to give Security for the several
Officers Writs due upon the Indictment aforesaid but for want thereof the said Thomas Blizard is con-
:mitted into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County thereto remanent & the said Sheriff to wit Joseph Meyer:
:ter by Littleton Townsend his deputy present took charge of the said Tho. Blizard accordingly &
Likewise the said Thomas Blizard present herein Court is ordered to give Security for his good behav-
:our and appearance at August Court next &c

Whereupon the said Thomas Blizard with John Deal Junr and John Gornwell his Securitys both of
Somerset County plaiders are present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves
Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary in manner and form following vizt the said Tho.
Blizard in twenty pounds Sterling and the said John Deal Junr and John Gornwell in ten pounds Sterl-
each good and lawfull money of England of their severall goods and Chattels Lands and tenements
of Every of them to be made and levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors if it
Happen that the said Thomas Blizard do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of
his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Widning Creek in the same County the third Tuesday
of August next and do not answer unto such things as shall be then & there objected against him on
his Lordships behalfs and do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon and do depart
the same Court without leave and in the meane time if he is not of the good behaviour to all his
Lordships good people &c

and they and each of them are accordingly discharged &c
