Their Oath do say that the said John Deal and Thomas Blizard are guilty and each of them are  
guilty of the trespass and assault above specified in manner and form as by the Indictment aff<sup>d</sup> first  
against them supposed - Wherefore all and singular the grievances by the Court here seen heard  
and fully understood Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the afo<sup>d</sup> John Deal &  
Thomas Blizard be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of his injuries by reason of the trespass upon  
and assault afo<sup>d</sup> Whil<sup>t</sup> certain John Deal & Thomas Blizard then and there present herein Court and  
prays themselves at peace with his said Lordship by Quoniam afo<sup>d</sup> and they are admitted and and there  
of they severally put themselves in mercy of this said Lordship and the fine of the same John  
Deal by the Justices here is affixed to thirty shillings curr<sup>t</sup> money and the fine of the same Tho.  
Blizard is affixed by the same Justices to thirty shillings curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland to the use of his  
said Lordship --- Whereupon the said Thomas Blizard is ordered to give Security for his severall  
Ouerrs manifested due upon the Indictment aff<sup>d</sup> but for want hereof the said Thomas Blizard is com-  
mitted into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County hereto remaine & the said Sheriff to sett Joseph Myer-  
son by Littleton Townsend his Deputy present took charge of the said Tho Blizard accordingly  
Likewise the said Thomas Blizard present herein Court is ordered to give Security for his good behav-  
our and appearance at August Court next the \_\_\_\_\_

Whereupon the said Thomas Blizard with John Deal Jun<sup>r</sup> and John Gornwell his Securitys both late of  
Somerset County pladew are present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves  
indebted unto his said Lordship the Proprietary in manner and form following vizt the afo<sup>d</sup> Tho.  
Blizard in twenty pound Sterling and the afo<sup>d</sup> John Deal Jun<sup>r</sup> and John Gornwell sixteen pounds Sterl-  
ling each good and true full money of England of their severall goods and chattels lands and tenements  
of every of them to be made and levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors if it  
happen that the said Thomas Blizard do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of  
his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Widm<sup>r</sup> Creek in the same County the third Tuesday  
of August next and do not answer unto such things as shall be then & there objected against him on  
his Lordships behalf and do not stand and abide his judgment of the Court herein and do depart  
the same Court without leave and in the mean time if he is not of good behaviour to all the  
Lordships good people

Thomas Adams <sup>and John Donkin</sup> appears according to his warrant to give Evidence against Deal and Blizard
